

BEFORE YOU APPLY, PLEASE READ

It is important that you work through this checklist before you start completing the Roslyn Z Wolf Award Application form.

This checklist has been designed to help you decide if this award is right for your project or organization, before you go through the time and expense of submitting an application.

You must be able to answer yes to all of the criteria:

Will your project

1. Impact the quality of life for families of Greater Cleveland?
2. Impact work of organizations that address educational development?
3. Implement a plan of constructive value for youth/education betterment for the children of Greater Cleveland, and a statement of qualitative outcomes of that plan?
4. Create coalitions and/or inspire others to action?
5. Maintain a level of volunteer and/or philanthropic commitment?
6. Further the mission of your organization (excluding fundraising and capital campaign efforts)?

The award will be given annually to any Greater Cleveland non-profit organization that, in the judgment of the awards committee, has made a significant impact in these areas during the previous year. This award is open to the Jewish and general communities.

The recipient of the award will be honored at NCJW, Cleveland Section's annual meeting in May with:

- \$5,000 grant from NCJW, Cleveland Section to be used as stated
- Name added to a recognition plaque on permanent display at NCJW, Cleveland Section office
- Small commemorative take-away for recipient
